Our Interact Club has identified a local non-profit organization that would benefit from our immediate help. Operation Giveback (OGB) empowers local school children who need additional academic and social nurturing. We've been to their facility, and the work they do is truly inspiring!



The OGB facility provides a comfortable, relaxed environment where students work hard on their after-school studies.

As part of their mission, OGB maintains a food pantry that provides after school nutrition and some evening meals. Their supplies are running down right now and we could make an immediate difference by helping to restock their shelves.

Here's what they need:

1. Non-perishable food items (canned soups, vegetables, beans)
2. Healthy snacks for children (e.g. cans/packs of fruit, applesauce)
3. Personal hygiene items
4. Clothes (gently used or unused)



The OGB pantry is used to provide after-school nutrition every T/W/Th, and dinner with the parents every Wednesday with dinner for the children on Thursdays.

Leave your monetary donations with Mrs. Balestra or Ms. Mink) Please have your supply donations turned in by January 29, 2016 and money donations by January 25.
